1. Read Acts 2:42. Which one of the four characteristics listed do you think needs the most work in our church and why? What are some practical ways we as a body can grow in that particular area?

2. What does Luke describe the young church spending its time doing? In what areas are the new believers focused upon? Are we still, today, to be focused upon the same things that they were focused upon 2,000 years ago or has things changed? How are things the same and how are they different?

3. Is Acts 2:45 teaching us to go and sell our property and give the proceeds to others? What are the principles being modeled in this particular verse?

4. In your own personal life, which one of the four areas listed in the sermon outline needs the most work in your life? What can you do to grow in that area? What is the heart attitude that is required and how do you grow in that attitude?

5. What are some additional thoughts and/or application from this morning's lesson? What does this passage teach you about the nature of man and about the nature of God?
