

GBC Application Questions

Grace Bible Church desires that you respond to this sermon by believing the gospel, obeying the Savior, and discipling the world for the glory of God. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions and praying through the issues will help you further meditate upon God’s Word in order to see how this can be done.

1. In what sense did Christ have to be ‘made perfect’ through sufferings? And what for (2:10)?

2. Why is Christ not ashamed to call those who trust him his brothers? (see 11b—13) If Christ is not ashamed to call us, His people, ‘brothers’, how should we treat one another in light of His example?

3. Knowing that Christ fulfilled God’s intention for mankind in that he fulfilled the promise of Psalm 8, how should that truth direct how we live?

4. In what sense did Satan hold the power of death (v. 14)? And in what sense has he been destroyed?

5. Why did Christ have to be made like his brothers in every way? (2:10)? How does Christ help us when we are tempted? Tempted by what?

6. How can you encourage someone else with what you’ve learned and thought through today? In what way could you hold someone accountable or have them hold you accountable?
