2. Read John 7:37. We have much to learn about the grace of God and in verse 37 His grace is particularly at the forefront. Why does the grace of God particularly stand out in verse 37 in light of the present context? What can we learn about the Lord Jesus from verse 37? How do we need to change in order to be more like Him?

3. If someone were to ask you, "How do you know that have 'drank' of Christ?" how would you answer their question? How does one know if they have drank?

4. What does verse 38 teach us about the results of salvation? What should someone's life look like who has truly believed on Christ according to verse 38?

5. What are some additional thoughts and/or application from this morning's lesson? What does this passage teach you about the nature of man and about the nature of God?
