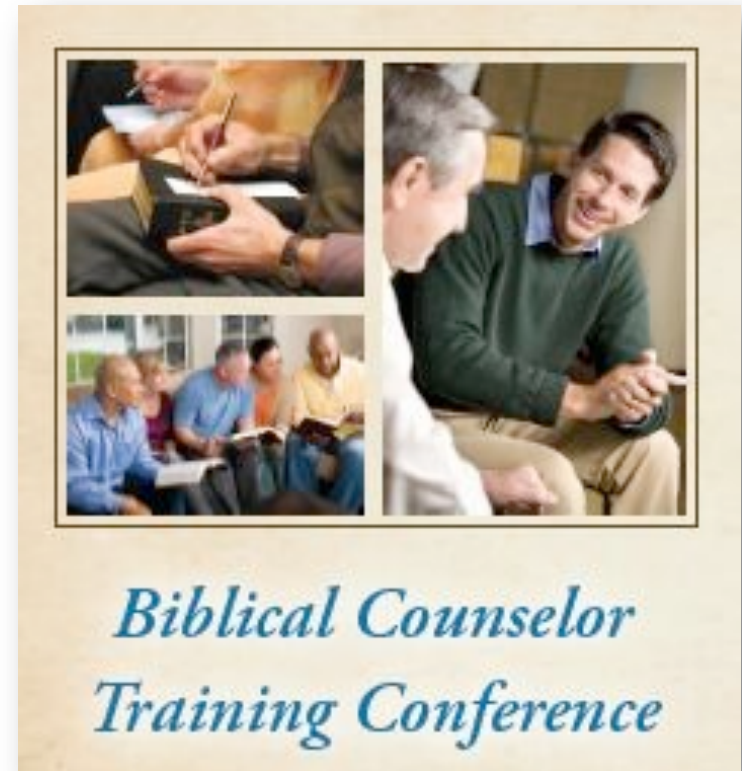

False Repentance = regret that his actions have consequences that hurt (usually to himself)

Dealing with Sin for God's Glory

Repentance

False Repentance = regret that his actions have consequences that hurt (usually to himself)

True Repentance = II Corinthians 7:10

They have sinned against a holy God

Dealing with Sin for God's Glory

Repentance

False Repentance = regret that his actions have consequences that hurt (usually to himself)

True Repentance = a change in mind about one's beliefs, attitude and behavior

False Repentance = regret that his actions have consequences that hurt (usually to himself)

True Repentance = evidenced not by words or feelings of regret, but by "fruit" resulting from a repentant heart
