

Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's message. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions and praying through the issues will help you further meditate upon God's Word in order to see the areas of your life that need change.

1. In verse 60, John refers to "many of His disciples." In John chapter 6 there are several groups that John mentions. Identify the different groups and their relationship with Jesus. Why are the disciples rather significant in John 6? Are they the same as "the twelve?" Why or why not?

2. Read John 6:62. What does Jesus mean by seeing "the Son of Man ascending to where He was before"? Is He referring to the cross? The ascension? Both? Neither? Explain.

3. In verse 63 Jesus says that it is the "Spirit who gives life." Earlier in this chapter Jesus said several times that He is the 'bread of life.' Well, who is it that gives life? Is it the Spirit or is it Jesus? How does this work?

4. In verse 64, John adds his editorial comment stating that Jesus knew who did not believe and He also knew who would betray Him. Why does John tell us that? Why does he bring up Judas at this point? What is he trying to teach us about the Lord Jesus?

5. What are some additional thoughts and/or application from this morning's lesson? What does this passage teach you about the nature of man and about the nature of God?
